



Christmas Moose



Materials:

Crochet hook 3,5 mm

Pipe cleaners x6

Black felt (used for shoes)

Leather cord (used for legs) approx. 40 cm

Pillow fillings

Llama baby Chunky....Colors:

Light brown, red, dark brown, white

Abbreviation:

Sc = Single crochet

St = Stitch

Rnd = round

Moose body: light brown yarn

1. 6 sc in a magic ring
2. (2 sc in each sc) repeat pattern (12 st)
3. (sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) repeat pattern (18 st)
4. (sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) repeat pattern (24 st)
5. (sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) repeat pattern (30 st)
6. (sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc) repeat pattern (36 st)
7. (sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc) repeat pattern (42 st)
8. (sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc) repeat pattern (48 st)
9. (sc in next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc) repeat pattern (54 st)
10. (sc in next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc) repeat pattern (60 st)
11. Rnds 11-16: sc around (60 st)
17. (8 sc, join 2 sc together) repeat pattern x6 (54 st)
18. (7 sc, join 2 sc together) repeat pattern x6 (48 st)
19. Sc around (48 st)
20. (6 sc, join 2 sc together) repeat pattern x6 (42 st)
21. Sc around (42 st)
22. (5 sc, join 2 sc together) repeat pattern x6 (36 st)
23. Sc around (36 st)
24. (4 sc, join 2 sc together) repeat pattern x6 (30 st)
25. Sc around (30 st)
26. (3 sc, join 2 sc together) repeat pattern x6 (24 st)
Stuff it with polyester while crocheting
27. (2 sc, join 2 sc together) repeat pattern x6 (18 st)
28. (sc, join 2 sc together) repeat pattern x6 (12 st)
29. (join 2 sc together) repeat pattern x6 (6 st)
30. (join 2 sc together) repeat pattern x3 (3 st)
Break the yarn

Christmas hat: red yarn

1. 6 sc in a magic ring
2. Sc around (6 st)
3. Sc around (6 st)
4. (2 sc in each sc) (12 st)
5. Sc around (12 st)
6. Sc around (12 st)
7. Sc around (12 st)
8. (sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) repeat pattern (18 st)
9. Sc around (18 st)
10. Sc around (18 st)
11. (sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) repeat pattern (24 st)
12. Sc around (24 st)
13. Sc around (24 st)
14. (sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) repeat pattern (30 st)
15. Sc around (30 st)

16. Se around (30 st)
 17. (sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc) repeat pattern (36 st)
 18. Sc around (36 st)
 19. Sc around (36 st)
 20. (sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc) repeat pattern (42 st)
 21. Sc around (42 st)
 22. Sc around (42 st)
 23. (sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc) repeat pattern (48 st)
 24. Sc around (48 st)
 25. Sc around (48 st)
- Break the yarn leaving a long end for assembling

Muzzle: Dark brown yarn

1. 6 sc in a magic ring
 2. (2 sc in each sc) repeat pattern (12 st)
 3. (sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) repeat pattern (18 st)
 4. (sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) repeat pattern (24 st)
 5. (sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) repeat pattern (30 st)
 6. Sc around (30 st)
 7. Sc around (30 st)
 8. Sc around (30 st)
 9. (3 sc, join 2 sc together) repeat pattern x6 (24 st)
 10. Sc around (24 st)
 11. Sc around (24 st)
- Break the yarn leaving a long end for assembling

Red spout:

1. 6 sc in a magic ring
 2. (2 sc in each sc) repeat pattern (12 st)
 3. Sc around (12 st)
 4. Sc around (12 st)
 5. Sc around (12 st)
- Break the yarn leaving a long end for assembling

Eyes x 2: white yarn

1. 6 sc in a magic ring
 2. (2 sc in each sc) repeat pattern (12 st)
 3. (sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) repeat pattern (18 st)
- Break the yarn leaving a long end for assembling

Eyes x2: dark brown yarn

1. 6 sc in a magic ring
 2. (2 sc in each sc) repeat pattern (12 st)
- Break the yarn leaving a long end for assembling

Ear x2: light brown yarn

1. 6 sc in a magic ring
 2. (2 sc in each sc) repeat pattern (12 st)
 3. Sc around (12 st)
 4. Sc around (12 st)
 5. Sc around (12 st)
- Break the yarn leaving a long end for assembling

Assembling:

The Christmas hat, muzzle, eyes, ears and the spout are sewn on to the body. Make a pair of white stitches in the eyes. The leather cord for the legs is fitted with a needle (with a large needle head). Shoes are made from felt, cut a hole in the middle of the shoes and put them on the leather cord. Make a small knot on the cord to hold the shoes in place.

Antlers are made out of 3 pipe cleaners twisted together into one long. It is folded with 4-5 serrations keeping approx. ½ pipe cleaner straight, then wrapped tight with yarn (color no. 6085). Leave approx. 1/4 of the straight pipe cleaner free and insert it through a stitch in the hat and into the body. Sew the antlers to the hat with a couple of stitches and adjust them so it sits nicely. (See picture)



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
